### **Dealing with vicarious trauma and compassion fatigue:**

For those who minister to others — priests, lay church workers, nurses, parents — years of caring for other peoples' struggles and problems can lead to something known as vicarious trauma, sometimes called compassion fatigue. The diocese of Saskatoon has invited Lorie Harrison, a registered professional counsellor with Legacy Ridge, to introduce some tools on how to recognize and manage vicarious trauma, including the development of resiliency skills.
