NUMBER OFFERED 1

ELIGIBILITY Student must:

- have achieved an admission average of 90% or greater
- be a resident of Saskatchewan
- have graduated from a Saskatchewan high school
- provide documentation (the “Documentation”) attesting to:
 - - having devoted an average of at least 1 hours weekly over 40 weeks during the prior year to compassionate activity(ies), including but not limited to: assistance to or visiting of isolated aged, weak, infirm or handicapped persons in their homes or community residence; or tutorial assistance to socially disadvantaged or physically handicapped children; or community service, together with two testimonials to this effect
 - - having devoted an average of at least 1 hours weekly over 40 weeks during the prior year to participation in individual or team sports and/or athletics, together with two testimonials to this effect

PREFERENCE *None*

SELECTION CRITERIA Selection will be made on the basis of academic achievement and submitted Documentation in a weighting of 70% academics, 15% compassionate activity and 15% sports or athletic activity, as determined by the Scholarships and Awards Committee.

As a condition of accepting this award, recipients will be required to authorize the Scholarships and Awards Committee to release such information as is allowed by current University policies and existing privacy legislation.

NOTE Renewable up to 3 years

Renewal Criteria:

As determined by the Scholarships and Awards Committee, students receiving an award will be eligible to have their award renewed annually up to three times, provided they:

- i. achieve an academic average of at least 75%;
- ii. provide a personal statement of less than 250 words outlining their academic progress, University experience and career objectives;
- iii. are full-time students; and
- iv. continue to be involved in both compassionate and sports or physical activities, as demonstrated by the submission of the requisite Documentation confirming same as set out above.
