Entering USask students are eligible for St. Thomas More College awards if they...

- are declared St. Thomas More College students (Arts and Science Students can declare at www.stmcollege.ca/declare)
- are a full time student (normally registered in 18 or more credit units during the fall and winter terms (September to April))
- are registered for 6 credit units of coursework through St. Thomas More College during the fall and winter terms (September to April)

WOLFE FAMILY GENERAL ACHIEVEMENT ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIP

Value: \$6,500

- achieved an admission average of 90% or greater
- resident of Saskatchewan and graduated from a Saskatchewan high school
- having devoted an average of at least 1 hours weekly over 40 weeks during the prior year to compassionate activity(ies)
- having devoted an average of at least 1 hours weekly over 40 weeks during the prior year to participation in individual or team sports and/or athletics
