- *Applications should be addressed to the STM Head of the Department in which the applicant proposes to teach.*

**DUTIES:** *The duties of a sessional lecturer include teaching, marking assignments and examinations, supervising the work of teaching assistants (if applicable), and having regular office hours.*

**STIPENDS:** *We offer competitive stipends and a compensation package that is comparable with the University of Saskatchewan.*

**QUALIFICATIONS:** *Preference will be given to candidates with a Ph.D. in the discipline. Demonstrated experience in the area of the course is expected. Candidates with a Masters Degree and appropriate experience will also be considered. St. Thomas More College recognizes seniority of sessional lecturers in accordance with Article 5.1.10.8 of its Collective Agreement.*

*Applicants should send a letter describing teaching and research strengths, a curriculum vitae, transcripts, documentation of teaching ability (if applicable), and two letters of reference.*
